



Introduction

Cleeve Motorsport Club welcome you to the 8th running of the

“Tour of the Cotswolds” on 15TH September 2019.

The event has no competitive element, and is intended as an opportunity for you to drive your pride and joy through picturesque parts of Gloucestershire, Worcestershire, Warwickshire and Oxfordshire. The total route distance is about 115 miles with a coffee break after 40 miles and a lunch break after about 78 miles. Younger, ‘interesting’ cars will be allowed, at the organisers’ discretion, **please ask**. The start will be at The Royal Oak in Bishops Cleeve GL52 8LR where a complimentary hearty full English breakfast will be supplied with tea or coffee. The finish will be at Seasons Restaurant, Swindon Village, Cheltenham GL51 9RX where a light buffet will be provided.

The day has been designed for two people, additional passengers are welcome and may be carried (for an additional fee of £10 per person).

You will be given an easy to follow tulip road book to take you along our carefully designed route which has been selected for its views and picturesque villages for your enjoyment. You are free to deviate from this route if you choose.

We look forward to welcoming you to this beautiful part of England and look forward to receiving your entry and seeing you on the day.

Regulations

ORGANISATION

1. Cleeve Motorsport Club will organise the "Tour of the Cotswolds", a Touring Assembly, on Sunday 15TH September 2019.
2. The event is being held under a certificate of exemption issued by the Motor Sports Association Ltd., these Regulations & any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
3. The MSA Certificate of Exemption Permit for the event is TBA

ELIGIBILITY

4. The event is open to four-wheeled road cars first registered before 1st January 1999. 'Interesting' later cars may be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
5. All cars must hold a V5 Registration Document and have a valid MOT certificate. Cars must not display any advertising, unless specifically agreed with the organisers, or carry any competition numbers on the doors.
6. Any person may enter the event. **No club membership is required.**
- 7 A Competition Licence is **not** required.

ENTRIES

8. Entries open on the publication of these Regulations, and close finally at noon on Saturday 7th September 2019. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the entry fee of **£50** if two people will be travelling in the car. Please add **£10** for each additional person. Each entry will be acknowledged in writing, (but preferably by e-mail).
Please make any cheque payable to '**Cleeve Motorsport Club.**' Final Instructions (including an Entry List and directions to the Start) will be posted (or e-mailed) during the week prior to the event.
Entries withdrawn before the 11th September will be refunded in full. Entries withdrawn after this date will be refunded but **may** be subject to a £20 administration charge.
9. **The entry fee includes** one Road book and one rigid Rally Plate plus 2 event souvenirs.

11. The maximum number of cars on the event is 40. The minimum is 20. Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and the full entry fee will be refunded. Entries will be selected in order of receipt, the running order being decided by the organisers. If an entrant particularly wants to run close to a friend then this should be noted in the appropriate space on the entry form.

ROUTE

12. The event will start at the Royal Oak, Bishops Cleeve GL52 8LR. The route will cover approximately 115 miles in Gloucestershire, Warwickshire, Worcestershire and Oxfordshire. The lunch halt will be after 80 miles where food and drink will be available for purchase.

13. The route will be defined using a tulip Road Book, which will be issued to entrants at the start of the event.

14 The start control will open at 9:30 and we would like cars to start at one minute intervals however entrants are free to start at any time they wish when start control is open.

DOCUMENTATION

16. To enable a relaxed documentation and breakfast entrants are requested to arrive at least 45 minutes before due start time.

17. All entrants must ensure that they have adequate insurance to enter the event, and the entry form contains a declaration to this effect that the driver must sign. The event has no competitive element.

18. After documentation, entrants will be given their Rally Plate (and two cable ties to assist fixing to the front of the car) and Road Book.

23. Competitors will be identified by a rigid rally plate, which will be supplied by the organisers. This must be displayed in a prominent forward facing position on the vehicle. Cable ties will be supplied to assist.
